Dear Families,

Applying for a school place for September 2019:

If you have a child in the nursery or in Year Two then it is time to be thinking about school places for September 2019. You will need to apply for Reception and Year Three places between **29th October 2018 and 15th January 2019**. The quickest and easiest place to apply for a school place is online; visit surreycc.gov.uk/admissions. We understand that choosing a school place can be a difficult decision and we are here to help.

Year Two parents can speak in confidence to a classteacher or to myself for guidance on local junior provision.

Parents in nursery can speak to their child's key person or to me about infant places. Remember that even though your child attends Fox Cubs you will still need to apply online for your place in the school. We really want all our lovely Fox Cubs to graduate to Fox Class next Autumn and are more than happy to chat this through with you 😊

For any questions regarding the application process, for example if you don't have access to the internet please speak to Mrs Snowden in the School Office.

Celebration Assembly:

On Fridays we celebrate our week of learning with a special assembly. The school gathers together in the hall and teachers nominate their star and citizen of the week. Next week we will be practising our Lock Down drill. This is always a difficult event to conduct with children but it is vital. Next Wednesday we will hold a short assembly explaining that we need to practise hiding in school in case there is an emergency. Mrs Lagar will talk to the children in Fox Cubs separately.
